In 2016 there were 66,000 prescription opioid deaths.

In the American Journal for Public Health, The CDC admitted to grossly inflating the overdose deaths. They reported a more accurate number was only 17,000.

15,400 of these overdose deaths were attributed to heroin alone. The remaining 1,600 were due to recreational use and poly-pharma.
