requiring certain response; providing for codification;
and providing an effective date. <EndFT>

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 3-604 of Title 43A, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

All licensed practitioners as defined in Section 353.1 of Title 59 of the Oklahoma Statutes shall respond appropriately and in a timely manner to a request for records or a request for consultation from an opioid substitution treatment program certified by the Department of Mental Health and Substance Abuse Services.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2019.
